- Have I relied on food or drinks to make me feel better or give me comfort instead of relying on God?
- Have I indulged in an excessive desire for certain foods or allowed myself to develop bad eating habits?
- Have I failed to fast on required fasting days or failed to offer sacrifices for the salvation of others?

THE VIOLET DRAGON OF LUST Agabah

- Have I mistreated my body or failed to take the proper care of my body to keep it healthy?
- Have I harmed my body or been ungrateful to God for the body He gave me?
- Have I failed to properly veil the sacred parts of my body or dressed in a way that was inappropriate?
- Have I failed to dress properly for the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the wedding feast of the Lamb?
- Have I failed to uplift other people in how they look and help them see their dignity as a child of God?
- Have I failed to see my own self worth as a son or daughter of God the Father?
- Have I failed to pray and seek discernment for God's will in my future vocation?
- Have I put my own selfish desires ahead of what is best for myself or for others?
- Have I used other people to get what I desire or allowed myself to be used by others?
- Have I failed to reflect on the crucifix and offer gratitude for the sacrifice Jesus made for me?
- Have I failed to imitate Jesus by picking up my own crosses to be His disciple?

HOW DO I GO TO CONFESSION?

1. PREPARE

- Do an Examination of Conscience.
- Pray to the Holy Spirit to help you, then plan what you will tell the priest.
- Read as a family the Parable of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32) and/or Psalm 51.

2. CONFESS

- You can usually choose the option of face to face or behind the screen. The priest welcomes you. Make the sign of the Cross.
- You may say, "Bless me, Father for I have sinned." Give an approximate time since your last confession. Tell your sins simply & plainly.
- Listen to the priest's advice and remember the penance he gives you. Say an act of contrition (Examples below).
 The priest absolves you.
- Do your penance right away if you can.
- Thank God for his mercy and love for you.

3. CELEBRATE

- As a family, burn your sins if written down to remember they are gone!
- Enjoy a steak or hamburger (Kill the fattened calf!) or another treat!

ACT OF CONTRITION

VERSION 1

Oh my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended thee. My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you, whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In His name, my God, have mercy. Amen.
