The first purple candle is known as the Hope candle, symbolizing the prophets who paved the way for Christ and the anticipation of his resurrection.





THE PEACE CANDLE

The second purple candle, referred to as the Peace candle, is traditionally lit counterclockwise. It reminds us of Mary and Joseph's journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem. With the coming of Jesus and the Holy Family, the light of peace shines forth from Bethlehem to all the world.

THE JOY CANDLE

The third candle is the Joy candle, distinguished by its pink or rose color. It symbolizes the joy experienced by the shepherds upon hearing the birth announcement. Jesus, our Shepherd, will bring everlasting joy to the world upon his return.





THE LOVE CANDLE

The fourth candle, often referred to as the Love candle, signifies the angels who announced His birth. The coming of Christ is expected to bring in peace and love throughout the entire world.

THE CHRIST CANDLE

The white center candle is the Christ candle which is lit on Christmas Eve, reminding us that Christ is the center of everything.
